Rates below are for Assembly Inn. For other housing options, please contact Kevin Morgan. If staying in housing other than Assembly Inn, a meeting room cost of \$10 per adult/youth, plus the cost of adult and children's meal plans are due to the church.

Rates for Adults and Youth include 2 nights lodging, 4 meals, meeting room, and sales tax. Children age 14 and younger stay free in rooms with parents. Additional charges indicated below.

Single Room Rate: \$245 Per Adult

Double Room Rate*: \$155 per Adult/Youth (2 adults/youth per room)

Triple Room Rate: \$132 per Adult/Youth (3 adults/ Youth per room)

Participants will arrive Friday night. Following check-in at Assembly

Inn, join us for ice-breaker games and informal fellowship, capped off with an ice cream social! Saturday morning, Adults, Youth and Children will enjoy separate programs. Our adults program will feature a "Bible Blitz" as Todd Hobbie takes us through the entire Bible in a few hours. We will spend time looking at the ancient wisdom of our faith heritage so that we might find ways to apply its truths to our modern times. We will meet in break-out groups as well to look at specific texts together. In addition to programs for elementary children and youth, childcare will be provided for infants and preschool children.

Saturday afternoon is time for our break-out groups, followed by 'free time'. Montreat is loaded with great activities, and our Retreat Committee will outline many possibilities for you to enjoy.

Saturday evening will be a time of intergenerational activity that will bring us all back together again.

Sunday Morning will feature an opportunity to worship together. We will take time to share a special communion service and give thanks to God.

All lodging, meals, and large group meetings will be held in Assembly Inn. The inn offers both single and double rooms. In addition, there are several larger rooms that provide space for up to four people. Handicap-accessible rooms are also available. Children age 14 and under can stay free in rooms with their parents. Linens are provided.

Rates include fees for meals and meeting space for adults. While children 4 years and under eat free, meal plans must be purchased for children and youth 5 and older. Note: If you reserve alternate housing, you still must pay the fees for meeting space and meals per adult and child.
